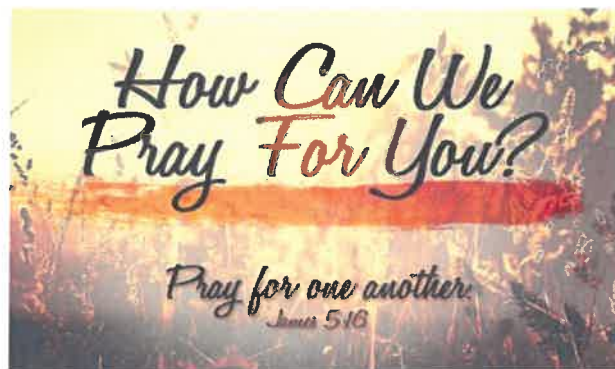
Happy New Year to all of you!

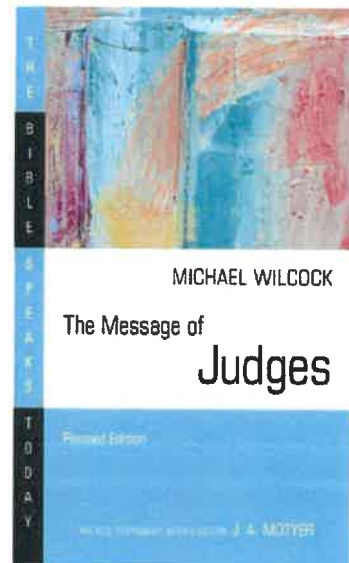

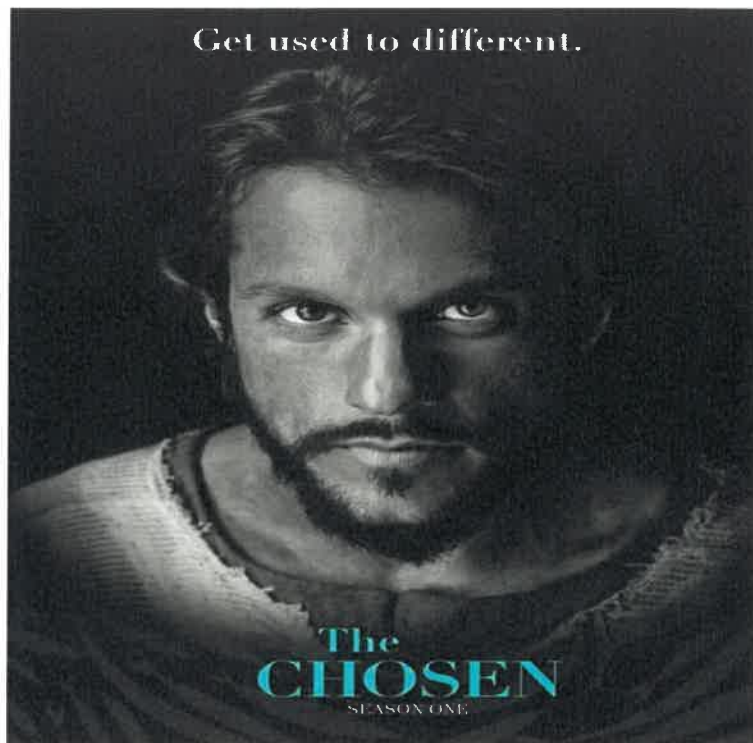
### **Men's Bible Study**

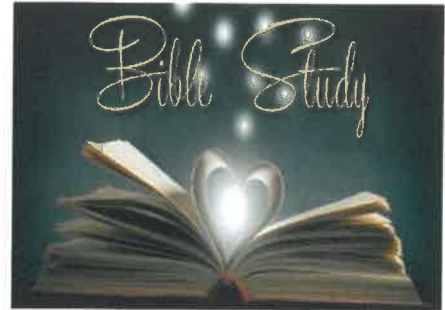
