





Time and Talent Pledges were mailed out in December, and we will offer them in worship on the First Sunday of Epiphany, January 7th!




#### Adult Choir

The Feast of the Epiphany is always **January 6th**, the day after the 12th Day of Christmas and this year it falls on Saturday. Our Burning of the Greens and Oyster Roast (5:30 - 7:30pm) includes candles and a huge bon fire which symbolizes the light of Christ going out into the world.
