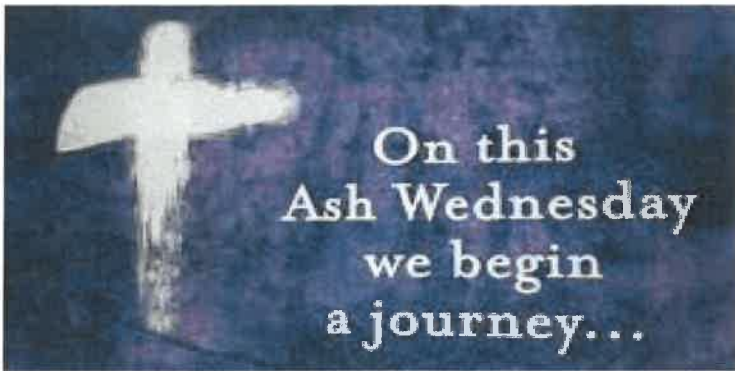

FROM OUR RECTOR

Dear Children of God,

What do you do to position yourself to perceive and receive more love, joy, peace and grace from Jesus? This is the effort of Spiritual Disciplines. Activities we do, or don't do, to pry our hearts open to perceive and receive more love from Jesus.

When I say it like that, it raises all kinds of questions. Why do I do this discipline? Or that discipline? These religious activities do not help me perceive and receive more love from Jesus! Ugh!

Well ... **the season of Lent is an opportunity** to review, restructure, change or try new disciplines! New Spiritual Disciplines that might begin to pry open my heart and make me available and attentive to the love Jesus desires for me to receive.

I intend to preach a short Lenten series on four essential Spiritual Disciplines that Dallas Willard suggests in this book, The Divine Conspiracy; Rediscovering our Hidden Life In God - Silence, Solitude, Worship and Study.

On the one hand we may think we know about these Spiritual Disciplines but on the other hand there is a depth available that most of us, myself included, have not experienced, yet.

1st Sunday of Lent - Wilderness Temptations  
2nd Sunday of Lent - Silence  
3rd Sunday of Lent - Solitude  
4th Sunday of Lent - Worship  
5th Sunday of Lent - Study

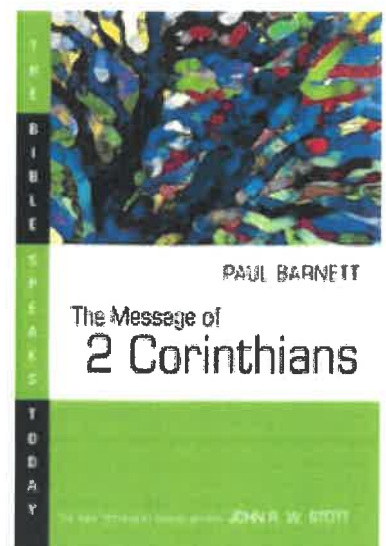
We hope you will join us each Monday as we discover the treasures God has to meet all of life’s challenges!

Although COVID protocols do not allow visitors inside the facility, staff met with us on the porch. In addition to the blankets, we delivered gallon bags of can pop-tops that Trinity parishioners have been saving. The Ronald McDonald House uses the pop tops to raise money to help with their expenses. A week later, we delivered 100 fleece blankets to St. Barnabas Lutheran church on Moultrie Street for the Afghan refugees that are moving to Charleston. Again, we could not meet directly with the refugees, but were able to meet with the staff who is coordinating the move. New projects are underway including a quilt for George and Pink when their new home is completed. The Sowing Circle meets the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of each month at 10:00 a.m. in Ms Jane's building. Due to a conflict, we will meet Saturday, March 26<sup>th</sup>. You do not have to know how to sew to take part in the Sowing Circle. Most projects involve cutting and tying and knotting. Everyone is welcome. Come help us sow..... for Jesus!

# Cursillo

## **in the Anglican Diocese of South Carolina is now SC Anglican Fourth Day Cursillo What is Cursillo?**

- \* “Cursillo” is Spanish for “a short course.” It is a movement of the church. Its purpose is to help those in the church understand their individual callings to be Christian Leaders.
- \* Cursillo is not designed to meet every spiritual need of every individual or group in the church. It is designed for the participant to “get away” from the daily routine, to listen to the Spirit and live for three days in Christian Community so that through study, worship, fellowship and introspection, one might sense the deeper calling of Christ in their lives to further service in His Church and know how to move forward on this journey.
- \* The overall goal of Cursillo is the goal of the Church: to bring all to Christ. This is done when informed, trained Christians set out with the support of others having a similar commitment. The Cursillo Weekend takes people who are already Christians and gives them foundational training based on the New Testament Christianity and helps them further discover their own “apostolic calling” based on their individual spiritual gifts!
- \* But most of all the Cursillo Weekend is about experiencing the unconditional Love of Jesus and Christian brothers and sisters in a way that you probably never have before. It is a taste of “Heaven on earth” and it is very often a life-changing event for participants!

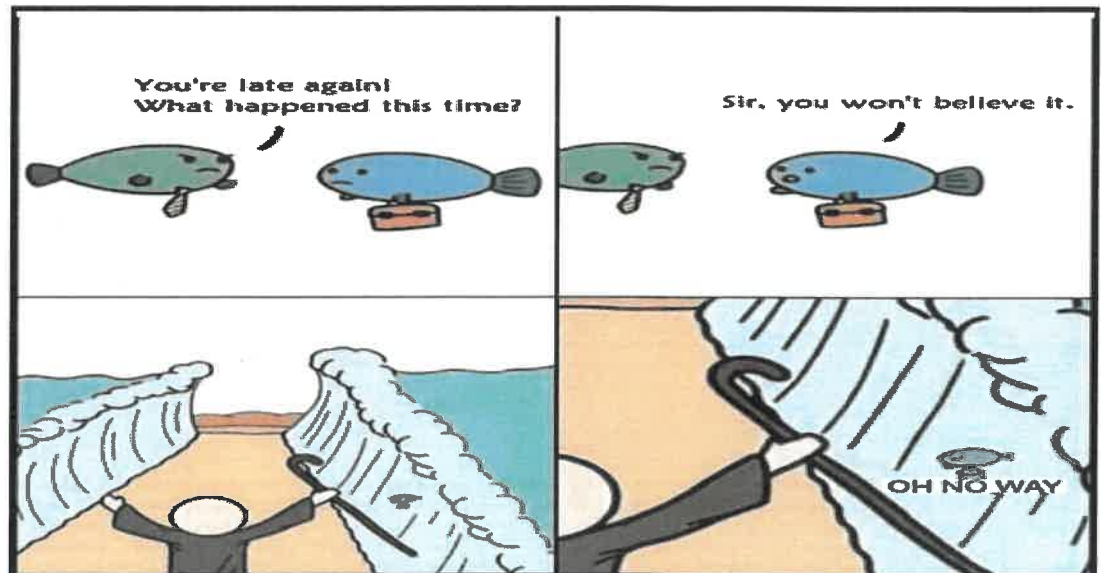

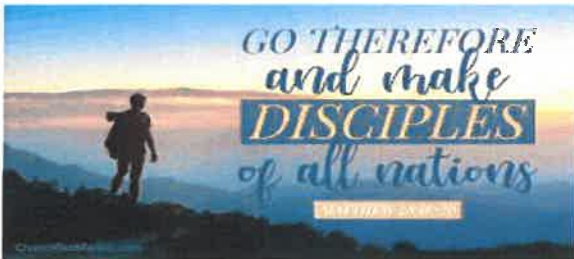

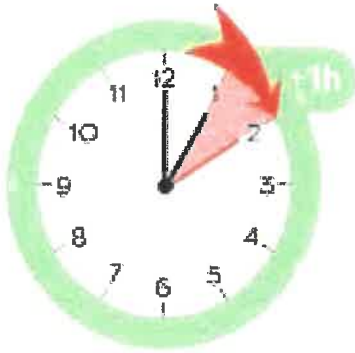
