Dear Children of God,

"Faith seeks understanding, faith builds on understanding, but faith does not finally depend upon understanding. Faith takes us to realms where explanation fails us." (The God I Don't Understand; Reflections on Tough Questions of Faith, by Christopher J.H. Wright, p.22)

My favorite text illustrating faith beyond understanding is about the Peace of God in Philippians 4:6-7 - 6 do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. 7 And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

And yet we desire to understand; Believer's and Unbelievers alike.

The Men's Bible Study is sponsoring our **Co-Ed Summer Book Club** and is offering a great option for Believers, Baby Believers and UnBelievers to delve into Tough Questions of Faith in the book, <u>The God I Don't Understand</u>. I enjoy reading a book with a few friends who bring their insights and questions to the discussion! Do you?

There is irony in this book and title - because the author, Christopher J.H. Wright has written other books titled <u>Knowing Jesus Through the Old Testament</u>, <u>Knowing the Holy Spirit Through the Old Testament</u>, and <u>Knowing the Father Through the Old Testament</u>.

That's a lot of published Knowing God to then go write and publish <u>The God I Don't Understand!!</u> Ha!

One of the things I like about this book is how Christopher Wright surveys and engages the contemporary, philosophical, <u>and Biblical</u> in a few short pages. Christopher Wright holds a very high view of the inspiration of Holy Scripture and includes the "difficult" texts as well.

Please consider picking up a copy of the book in the Reception Office at Trinity and joining us for the Summer Book Club! Our first session is at 9:00am on Thursday, June 15th.




As always we welcome anyone who would like to join us. We have fun as witnessed by our Easter group! It was not only spectacular decor but done in record time.


"No Homework" Bible Study

On July 25, 2023 Bishop Abraham will preach at our 8am Beach Service and our 10:00am Historic Sanctuary Service.






ANNOUNCEMENTS FROM VESTRY

I would like to welcome **Charlie**Vincent as our new 3rd week chef. For those who may not know him, he runs the Yacht Club on the beach.




